Choose where you live and who you live with through My Home, Achieve Australia's home-based support service.

My Home provides NDIS funded living and support services designed to assist people with disability to have choice about how they are supported in their home so they can reach their full potential.

We offer shared and individual support options for people with disability to live independently or with housemates, with support available 24 hours a day or as needed.

Achieve will support you to find a home and supports which will best meet your day-to-day needs.

- Supported Independent Living (SIL)
- Individualised Drop-in support
- Community access support
- Registered Nursing support
- Daily and Assistance with Self-Care Activities

Drop-In Support

These services are designed to support individuals who live in their own, or family home, have transitioned to, or who want to transition to, more independent living arrangements.

Drop-in support facilitates independent living by:

- Providing assistance with daily tasks - cooking and cleaning
- Offering in-home care
- Facilitating community access

- Increasing social connections

- Supporting the management of health and wellbeing

We maintain an open line of communication with family members and nominees to ensure appropriate supports are maintained throughout various life stages.

Summer Hill House

Summer Hill House offers short term accommodation for people with intellectual disability, high physical support and/or complex health needs.

Guests have their own bedroom, access to the interactive sensory room, a specially designed spa

bath, our peaceful gardens and the shared living spaces to dine, watch television or play games.

We organise events and regular group activities throughout the year.
