## We understand what makes SDA work

Strong SDA outcomes rely on more than occupancy rates, they depend on getting the right people and supports in place and sustaining this.

### Our approach is designed to:

- Bring participants together carefully into homes as housemates
- Support stable, long-term living arrangements
- Maintain occupancy rates
- Minimise the disruptions of transitions

When the right supports are in place, SDA housing becomes a home, and people choose to stay long-term.

## We work alongside SDA providers

We take a coordinated, partnership-led approach to every home. That includes:

- Early involvement in participant compatibility assessment
- Structured transition planning and onboarding
- Thorough risk assessment and mitigation planning
- Collaborative multidisciplinary teams
- Clear, consistent communication
- Shared problem-solving when challenges arise

You're not managing supports separately, you're working with a provider who understands how housing and support must align for participant outcomes.
