
As outlined in our previous letter, Achieve will be providing Supported Independent Living and Community Participation services on or about 21 October. We are on track for a seamless transition that we believe will feel like no change at all for participants.

From the same time, IHA will be your Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) provider, and will be taking care of the houses you or your loved one lives in. Achieve and IHA have a lot of experience working together but we deliver services separately to safeguard each person's right to make their own decisions and exercise choice and control.

From later next month, Ainsley will have responsibility for South East Queensland and Karen will remain on secondment to Brisbane for three months.

Ainsley and Karen want to listen and learn and answer any questions you have including about the paperwork we need families and guardians to sign as part of the

transition. This includes a Statement of Service, Service Agreement and Consent form.

Thank you to all families and guardians who have provided their consent for us to contact you. This has enabled Ainsley and Karen to spend time with Mercy Community staff to gain a thorough understanding of the support needs of individuals.

Ainsley and Karen are excited to start visiting people in their homes to get to know them. If you would like to meet our general managers at your loved one's home, please let us know so this can be arranged.

We are also pleased to tell you that employment contracts have been issued to every disability support staff member who supports you or your loved one. We have extended an invitation to each staff member to meet with Ainsley, Karen or one of our two senior HR managers in South East Queensland supporting the transition.

The team has received a great response from staff with more than half booking in for a meeting already.

Update from IHA

We'd like to take this opportunity to introduce you to **Rebecca Egan** – also known as Beck [pictured below].

Beck is the Customer Engagement Manager for IHA and brings a wealth of experience in tenancy and SDA management. She will be your main point of contact moving forward.

Beck will soon reach out to you by email to provide a new Accommodation Agreement and Residential Tenancy Agreement. These documents will require your attention and signature. Beck is available to support you throughout this process and wants to ensure that everything goes smoothly for you.
