We are a provider of choice in complex and clinical support

Achieve delivers highly specialised, quality services for people with disability who have complex needs. Most people we support are in Supported Independent Living (SIL), while others are supported in centre-based community participation and drop-in support, supported employment, and respite services.

Most clients have intellectual disability, and high clinical and/or behavioural support needs. We have an integrated multidisciplinary approach that combines clinical, health, social and disability support delivered by a committed team.

Achieve's accommodation services offer a mix of registered nursing and support worker models. These include on-site active overnight supports, psychosocial supports and high physical supports that are tailored to suit a wide range of needs.

Many people require a range of supports including high intensity personal activities. These include complex bowel care, enteral feeding and management, tracheostomy care, urinary catheter management, complex wound management, seizure management and dysphagia management.

We take a relationship driven collaborative approach

We work collaboratively with people, their families and circle of support to ensure they get the required tailored supports. This often originates through an introduction from a referrer, such as a support coordinator, hospital discharge team, specialist disability accommodation provider, general practitioner or other service provider.

We build relationships with everyone in the circle of support to ensure that the person receives the support they need to be well, have a home, choose a career, learn new skills, participate in their community and enjoy a full life.



We are experts in behaviour support plan implementation and trauma informed care

We have robust, organisation-wide behaviour support plan implementation guidelines. Achieve team members are trained in implementing individual behaviour support plans. We collaborate with specialist behaviour support providers to support the development of behaviour support plans and implement strategies in the plan that promote choice and control, quality of life, and safety.

We have clinical experts to train and guide our support team

Our Customer and Practice team includes a dedicated practice lead for behaviour support and an experienced clinical team of sector professionals. This team places people's needs at its centre and integrates client participation with organisational governance in the planning, decision-making and delivery of clinical supports.

It can take days or weeks if the need is urgent, or longer if recruitment of team and training or socialisation is required; or a person's new living environment requires modifications to suit their needs.
